JACOPO RAMIREZ ALESSANDRI - Uilleann pipes / Flute

Started to play the guitar at the beginning of high school, he very soon discovered the love for celtic music and started to play the Tin whistle (typical Irish flute) and the Great Highland Bagpipe.

After some years of study he decided to go deeper in the Irish music learning the Uilleann pipes, the traditional Irish bagpipes with his charming and unique sound. He followed Uilleann Pipes classes both in Italy and Ireland with the greatest Irish musician. From 2013 to 2016 he was part of "L'Aquavite", a songwriting project where he could experiment the fusion of traditional music with more modern sounds. In 2015 he joins the Daran, a very active traditional Irish music band.

In 2016 he started to be interested in historical music and from 2017 he is part of the Compagnia Saltafossum where he performs medieval and renaissance music throughout many festivals all around Italy. In 2018 he started a duo project, "Cantì Jaramme", with the singer and artist Filomena D'Ambrosio where he performs traditional music from south of Italy playing guitar and Zampogna (a typical bagpipe from south of Italy) with exhibitions also outside of Italy in Mosca and Melnik (Bulgaria).
